Summary of Institution Mission and Student Achievement

Through quality distance education programs, excellence in teaching and research, and strong connections to the cybersecurity industry, EC-Council University (ECCU) aspires to be a global leader in cybersecurity education. ECCU is committed to preparing learners with the knowledge, skills, and competencies required to succeed in dynamic and evolving professional environments.

ECCU evaluates student achievement through multiple performance indicators including graduation rates, retention rates, student satisfaction, and employment outcomes. These measures are regularly monitored to ensure alignment with institutional mission and continuous improvement.

Aggregated Institutional Data on Student Achievement

Retention Rates

ECCU demonstrates strong student persistence and engagement:

- **2024 Retention Rate:** 94.2%
- **2025 Retention Rate:** 94.4%

Student Satisfaction

ECCU consistently achieves high student satisfaction levels:

- 87.0% of ECCU students were positive about achieving the goals they had at the beginning of their respective courses/programs.
- 87.0% of ECCU students were satisfied with their studies with EC-Council University.
- 84.0% of ECCU students stated they would recommend EC-Council University to a friend

Job Placement and Career Outcomes

ECCU graduates report strong career alignment and outcomes:

- 83% agreed that their goals were achieved when you started the course or program
- 92% agreed that they were satisfied with the studies/program at ECCU
- 90% stated their education prepared them for work and career goals.
- 84% reported being employed at the end of their program
- 83% agreed that the education at ECCU helped to enhance their career.
- 92% agreed that they would recommend ECCU programs/studies to a friend

Graduation Rates at ECCU

EC-Council University (ECCU) Graduation Rates: Graduation rates are based on the number of students who successfully graduate from a specific starting cohort. ECCU does not have programs which establish cohorts. However, using DEAC guidance, we have set annual cohorts for the purpose of tracking graduation rates. As an institution offering flexible, online programs primarily serving working professionals, student progression and completion timelines may vary based on individual circumstances such as employment commitments, pace of study, and program flexibility.

Therefore, ECCU evaluates both:

- **Current Graduation Rates** (students who have completed within the defined timeframe), and
- **Projected Graduation Rates** (including students who are currently continuing or inactive but expected to complete)

This approach provides a more comprehensive and accurate reflection of student success.
